Victoria Harbour Resort Guidelines

Booking

Reservations taken all year round. Guest can choose site if available. Guests provided with site number on completion of booking.

Cancellation

If more than 14 days notice is given, a \$20.00 administration fee will be charged. Less than 14 days notice to cancel will result in the original deposit being forfeited.

Deposit

Deposit taken on booking reservation via credit card.

Payment Method

Visa, MasterCard, Debit & Cash. All Rates are in Canadian Dollars.

Vehicles

One (1) vehicle per site only.

Tents

Tents are not permitted.

Pets

Upper Campground Only: Well behaved pets are welcome. Certain dog breeds are not permitted, please check with the Team when making your reservation. Pets must be on leash at all times. Excessive noise or allowing pets to roam off leash could result in you being asked to leave the Resort. Pets are restricted to the Upper Campground, and are not allowed in the Lower Campground or on the beach.

Campfires

Open wood burning fires and fireworks are not permitted. Please check the fire policy.

Quiet Time

11:00 pm – 8:00 am daily.

Additional

The beach is glass free.

Sound equipment is not permitted.

Wrist bands are provided, and must be worn on Resort property.

NOTICE TO USERS OF THE RESORT FACILITIES ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND WAIVER AND RELEASE OF CLAIMS PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

In consideration of Parkbridge allowing the RESORT USER onto its Property to use and enjoy the Property and to participate in Activities, the RESORT USER agrees as follows:

1. THE RESORT USER ASSUMES AND ACCEPTS, WITHOUT LIMITATION, ALL RISKS AND DANGERS associated with the RESORT USER'S use and enjoyment of the Property and participation in any of the Activities.
2. THE RESORT USER ASSUMES FULL RESPONSIBILITY for understanding and following the rules and safe practices associated with the use and enjoyment of the Property, participation in any of the Activities, and for his or her own personal safety.
3. THE RESORT USER WAIVES ANY AND ALL CLAIMS that he or she has or may have in the future against Parkbridge and its parent, subsidiaries and affiliated entities and their respective directors, officers, employees, agents, volunteers, contractors and assigns arising from or connected, directly or indirectly, with the RESORT USER'S presence at, or use and enjoyment of, Parkbridge's Property, and the RESORT USER'S presence at, or participation in, any of the Activities.
4. THE RESORT USER RELEASES Parkbridge from any and all liability for any loss, damage, injury or expense that he or she may suffer or incur by reason of his or her presence at, or use and enjoyment of, the Property, and presence at, or participation in, any of the Activities, due to any cause whatsoever, INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE, BREACH OF CONTRACT, OR BREACH OF ANY STATUTORY DUTY OF CARE, INCLUDING ANY DUTY OF CARE OWED UNDER ANY APPLICABLE OCCUPIERS' LIABILITY LEGISLATION ON THE PART OF PARKBRIDGE, OR OTHER PARTICIPANTS, OR ANYONE ELSE.
